<p style="text-align: center;"><b>GET SKETCHING</b></p> <p>Find a picture or photograph of a person, place or object and have a go at sketching it.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>JUNK MODELLING</b></p> <p>Collect and recycle materials such as yogurt pots, toilet rolls and boxes and see what you can create with them.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>PLAY DOUGH</b></p> <p>Make an animal, a face or some cakes with playdough or have your own dough disco!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>PERFORM A RHYME</b></p> <p>Learn a nursery rhyme and add some actions. Introduce it and perform it to someone.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>MY FAMILY</b></p> <p>Draw a picture of your family. Can you label them with their names?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>HIDE AND SEEK</b></p> <p>Play with a grown up or a brother or sister. You could even ask a grown up to hide some of your cuddly toys. Can you find them?</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>ANIMAL GUESSING GAME</b></p> <p>Describe an animal to a grown up. How many legs does it have? Does it have fur or feathers? Where does it live? Can they guess what it is?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>MAKE A JIGSAW</b></p> <p>Cut up a picture (maybe from a magazine or colouring book) into 6 or 8 pieces. A grown up could draw lines for you to cut along. Can you put the pieces back together again?</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>MAKE A SANDWICH</b></p> <p>Spread the butter and add a filling. Fold your bread and cut in half. Enjoy eating your own sandwich!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>SORTING</b></p> <p>Sort out your toys into different piles. How will you sort them? By colour? By size? By type? Maybe you could sort some other things from your house.</p>

Easy play dough recipe:

- 10 spoonfuls of flour
- 5 spoonfuls of salt
- Add water gradually to mix
- Knead dough
